EARLY DISMISSAL

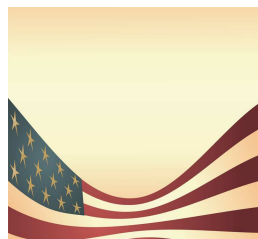

Thank you so much for making this fundraiser possible. Many families participated, and we really appreciate your support.



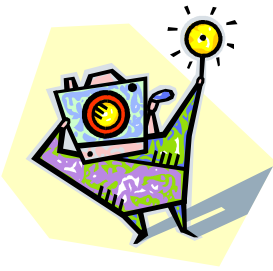

Marks for the first trimester will close on Friday, November 18. Report cards will be sent home on Wednesday, November 30.

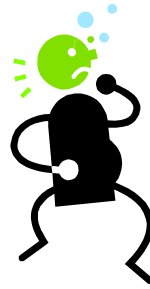


For your planning purposes, two sessions of parent/teacher conferences have been planned. The first one will take place Thursday evening, December 1,

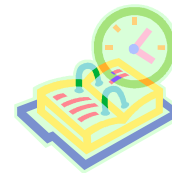


HEALTH ISSUES
