

## Uniforms can be purchased at Collegiate House in Medford

### Full Uniform

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- GIRLS – GRADES K – 3

- Uniform jumper
- White blouse with long/short sleeves and Peter Pan collar
- Navy blue knee socks/tights
- Navy blue uniform sweater (winter)

- GIRLS – GRADES 4 – 5

- Uniform skirt (must be knee-length)
  - White blouse with long/short sleeves
  - Navy blue V-neck uniform vest
  - Navy blue knee socks/tights
  - Belt (if wearing pants)
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- GIRLS – GRADES 6, 7 & 8

- Navy blue skirt (must be knee-length)
  - White blouse with long/short sleeves
  - Gray V-neck uniform vest
  - Navy blue knee socks/tights
  - Belt (if wearing pants)
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- BOYS – GRADES K – 3

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Preschool Students – Boys & Girls

Uniform must be worn with sneakers – sandals and flip-flops are NOT allowed.

- Navy blue sweatshirt w/logo
- Navy blue T-shirt w/logo
- Navy Blue sweatpants w/logo

SUMMER: navy blue shorts w/logo

**Everyday Uniform**

- Twill navy pants
- Twill navy skirt/skort/jumper (just above the knee)
- Knit shirt (light blue or grey with SAS logo)
- Dark colored shoes or **all black** sneakers (no high tops)
- Navy blue socks
- Polo shirt may also be worn with navy dress pants or skirt

### **P.E. Uniform**

PE uniforms must be purchased from Collegiate House. The navy-blue sweatshirt, sweatpants, t-shirt, or shorts must have the SAS logo. If a tee shirt is worn under the sweatshirt, it still must have the SAS logo.

### **N.U.T. Day Clothes**

No Uniform Today (N.U.T Day) is a special way to celebrate different themes or events throughout the school year. Appropriate attire must be worn. Shirts with inappropriate logos, and ripped, oversized jeans, are not allowed. Girls may not wear spaghetti straps, short shorts, or crop tops. Modest sleeveless shirts may be worn. Skirts should pass the "fingertip rule". Flip-flops and slippers are not allowed. If students have P.E. on a nut day, they must wear sneakers. Students may have a NUT Day on their birthday. HATS are NOT allowed

### **Footwear**

Students wear black or dark-colored (including soles) sneakers or shoes. No high tops, high heels, flip-flops, or slippers are allowed. During the winter, children can carry their regular shoes to school so that they can wear them once their boots are removed.

### **Students' Personal Appearance**

Personal appearance is very important. Students should be well-groomed at all times. Nails should be kept clean and trimmed. No extreme hairstyles, designs, or colored streaks are allowed. Students' hair may not cover their eyes. Make-up is not allowed. Boys' hair must be kept short, above the shirt collar, and neat.

Jewelry is limited to a watch and chain with a cross or medal (small – 1" or less). Girls may wear up to 2 earrings per ear. Earrings should be studs or small hoops, which hug ear lobes. Boys may not wear earrings.

**\*\* Girls' headbands must be black, navy, or school uniform plaid.**

**\*\* Smart Watches are NOT ALLOWED in school**
